Program: is provided, with guidelines, by the parish family. A sample is attached/included.

Music: Ministry is provided by the parish family. If additional/other musicians are requested, they must be provided for by the family. In addition, the music ministry is to be paid their fee as consultation/provisions must be made by them. Given the nature of a funeral celebration, cantors are welcome, however, "soloists" are not recommended. If practice is required with outside/parish music ministry, additional fees may be incurred.

Placing of the Pall/Placing of Religious Symbol: (used when a body is present): Family members/pall bearers (funeral directors will assist/direct). 2/4 may place the pall/1 may place the cross/2 may place the Book of the Gospels.

Carrying of the Cremains: once placed in the Church Repository, 2 may carry and place the repository on the table in the center aisle.

Flowers: Generally welcome and accepted, to be left in Church. A maximum of 3 baskets are allowed at the parish cemetery. It is highly recommended that extras be given/taken to local nursing/assisted living homes or hospitals, even back to the family.

Pictures: an appropriate 8x10 is welcome at church when cremains are present. (It will be placed appropriately during the service/mass on the lower shelf of the repository or on the altar.)
