Reflection: Ordinary Time: 2nd Sunday of the Year: Only during the cycle of readings C are we treated to several epiphanies in a row: Epiphany: the manifestation to the Magi; then the Epiphany: Jesus' baptism revealed for the saving waters for us; this week: the Epiphany: the first miracle of the wedding feast at Cana.

Thank God for Mother May who points out the need for Jesus' to begin his ministry. Her simple phrase: "They have no more wine" could have been met with a skeptical: "so what?" Instead, it is an invitation for Jesus to get about his ministry: truly His "hour" has not yet arrived! That will happen during the Last Supper/Calvary.

For the present moment there will be "little hours" when Jesus' abundant revelation will be more fully revealed. Still we're left with the question: "what is Jesus' hour?" I read this brief & awesome description: In the Gospel God's abundance is revealed. Not one jar of water become wine, but six! Not a little bit of wine, but over 100 gallons! Not partially filled jars, but "to the brim"! Not inferior wine, but "good wine"! Not just one sign, but the "beginning of His signs"! More is coming! The more is the Glory of God revealed. In the "more" is God's abundance – a sign of the fullness of Life and love God offers us.

It's like the anticipation of the re-opening of our Church at St Mary's. Something we're excited about & can't wait for! So too as we walk with the Lord through this Year of Mercy & St. Luke's Gospel!
