# Liturgy & Worship

**What is sin?** *Sin is an offense of His Law.*

How many kinds of sin are there? There are 2 kinds of sin: original sin and actual sin.

What is original sin? Original sin is the sin which mankind committed in Adam, the head of the human race, and which every descendant of Adam inherits by bodily generation.

Here we find depicted the temptation and sin of Adam and Eve. They were our first parents, created by God and placed by Him in the terrestrial paradise, where they lived in complete happiness, until the envious devil disguised himself as a serpent and tempted them.

To test their fidelity God had forbidden Adam and Eve to eat the fruit of a certain tree. But the devil urged, "Eat of this fruit; you will become like God"! Eve, letting herself be persuaded, picked the fruit, ate of it, and gave some to Adam. Thus, with the hope of becoming as great as God, they disobeyed His command and committed a grievous sin.

In punishment for their sin, Adam and Eve lost sanctifying grace and the right to heaven. They became subject to suffering and death, and to a strong inclination to evil. Moreover, God sent them out of the earthly paradise.

On account of the sin of Adam, we, his descendants, come into this world with original sin, that is, deprived of sanctifying grace. However, God did not abandon man after Adam fell into sin, but He sent into the world His Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, to free man from his sins and to reopen to him the gates of heaven. Our Savior instituted the Sacrament of Baptism to take away original sin. "For just as by the disobedience of the one man the many were constituted sinners, so also by the obedience of the one the many will be constituted just". Rom. 5:19
