The Sacraments

A sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ to give grace. There are seven sacraments. The sacraments receive their power to give grace from God through the merits of Jesus Christ. All sacraments give "sanctifying grace". Each of the sacraments also gives a special grace called "sacramental grace". Sacramental grace helps us to carry out the particular purpose of the sacrament.

The sacraments always give grace if we receive them with the right dispositions.

There are a few important actions and words which can cause a great movement of "sanctifying grace" into our souls. This sanctifying grace continues to work in our souls in the form of many "actual graces" in daily life.

The number and power of these graces of the sacraments depend very much upon the love and preparation with which they are received. As far as God's power is concerned, the simple words and actions of a sacrament can produce an avalanche of graces in our souls.
