#### "I believe in the Holy Spirit"

The Holy Spirit is God and the third Person of the Blessed Trinity. He is equal to the Father and the Son because He is God. He sanctifies through the gift of grace and dwells in the Church as the source of its life.

Grace is a supernatural gift of God bestowed on us through the merits of Jesus Christ for our salvation. There are two kinds of grace: sanctifying grace and actual grace. Sanctifying grace is that grace which confers on your soul a new life, that is, a sharing in the life of God Himself. The chief effects of sanctifying grace are:

- a) It makes you holy and pleasing to God.
- b) It makes you an adopted Child of God.
- c) It makes a temple of the Holy Spirit.
- d) It gives you the right to heave.

Sanctifying grace is necessary for salvation. It is the supernatural life which alone enables you to attain the supernatural happiness of heaven. Actual grace is a supernatural help of God which enlightens your mind and strengthens your will to do good and the avoid evil. Unfortunately, you can resist the grace of God. Your will is free, and God does not force you to accept His grace. Actual grace is necessary for all who have attained the use of reason. Without it you cannot resist the power of temptation nor perform other actions which merit a reward in heaven.

The principal ways of obtaining grace are prayer and the sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist. You can make your most ordinary actions merit a heavenly reward by doing them for the love of God and by keeping yourself in the state of grace.
